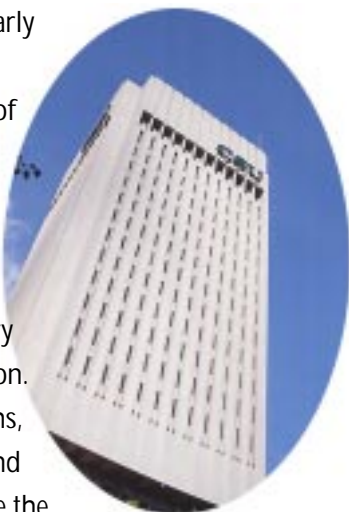

The Library maintains a collection of over two million items and access to more than 14,400 journals in print and electronic form. Its staff of professionals includes information specialists in all areas.

Cleveland State University has matured into a comprehensive research institution. It anchors the downtown community and provides not only undergraduate programs, but also a wide variety of graduate programs with their accompanying scholarly components. The Library is the heart of this research and teaching institution. In many disciplines, library collections constitute the primary source of information. Journals, monographs, special collections, and electronic sources are the means for scholarly communication.
